Application Procedure And Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Apply over Dulux Copper Effect. Best results are achieved if treatment begins as soon as the final coat of Dulux Copper Effect is touch dry (approximately 2 hours) and within 12 hours of application. Prepare surfaces as per Dulux Copper Effect label. Apply Dulux Copper Patina solution by brush or muslin in a random pattern. The aged effect will continue to develop over days and weeks. A second coat can be applied if required. Do not apply a clear sealer as this can remove or damage the effect, especially when new. Individual results will vary due to the application method and environment. The patina can be rubbed off when touched.

Individual results may vary due to film thickness, methods used, time elapsed, ambient temperatures, substrate, etc.
